Park Ranger, Lori Owenby, will talk about the different mushrooms growing right here in the forest floors. Come learn about all the native species that grow in Catawba County. The second half of the program will focus on cultivating your own shiitake mushroom. Each participants will be able to inoculate their own logs. Please bring two freshly cut hardwood (preferably oak) logs. Logs should be cut two weeks before the workshop and be approximately 4-8" in diameter and 3-4' long. **Lunch included**
