RULES:

- * Posters should measure between 18 and 24 inches high and 24 and 30 inches wide (no larger).
 - * Any weight of paper is permitted.
 - * Use marker, crayons, watercolor, ink, acrylic, tempera paints or colored pencils. Please NO pastels, chalk or pencil drawings.
 - * Do not put your name or writing on the front of the poster.
 - * Entries must be flat (don't fold, matt, roll, mount or laminate)
 - * The entry form must be securely attached to the back of the entry with tape.
