Nationally certified 4-H Shooting Sports instructors from our state will direct the learning experiences. Participants must be at least 21 years old and be registered as a 4-H volunteer in their county. A limited number of junior leaders age 18 -21 may be accepted if space allows. Participants will be selected through an application process. No more than 15 participants will be selected in the disciplines of rifle, shotgun, archery, muzzleloading and hunting. **The cost for the weekend workshop is \$75 per person. Make Checks payable to: NC AG FOUNDATION for NC 4 H SHOOTING SPORTS** Please rank your first, second, and third choice of discipline area. You will participate in only one discipline throughout the entire weekend long training.

Any discipline may be cancelled within one week of the workshop start date if an instructor cannot be located, or if registration for a discipline is low. It is important to list and rank up to 3 disciplines.
