

# NCAEPAAT Early Career Award

Objective: To recognize current NCAEPAAT members with 5 or less years of experiences and accomplishments in their program area.

Award: Plaque

Eligibility requirements:

1. Applicant must have 12 months but less than 5 years of Extension employment.
2. Attach a letter of support from supervisor.
3. Use standard type; do not reduce. (12 point)
4. Complete and send 3 copies to the NCAEPAAT Awards chairman by June 1<sup>st</sup>. (Must be postmarked by due date)
5. Must be active member of the NCAEPAAT. (Dues must be paid by March 1<sup>st</sup> to qualify)
6. Application should reflect primarily accomplishments of the past 12 months, but may include MAJOR past accomplishments.
7. One award will be given in each program area. (4-H, Ag. and FCS)

Specific Criteria:

1. Professional Contributions to NCAEPAAT
2. Program Accomplishments.
3. Teamwork with staff, volunteers and community.
4. Applicant may receive this award only once.

Scoring scale:

- 30 points-- NCAEPAAT offices held, committee and other work
- 5 points-- Awards and Recognition
- 5 points-- Committee work in Extension
- 5 points-- Professional Improvement, teamwork
- 50 points-- Professional Accomplishments (limited to 2 additional pages)
- 5 points-- Personal and Community
