### 2007 Awards and Recognition Annual Report

1. Committee members were kept informed and involved by the State Vice President for Awards and Recognition via email. District VPs encouraged agents to apply for awards and shared information about rules, procedures, and award changes.
2. The State VP worked with webmaster to update the awards page.
3. Twenty-six individuals and eleven teams submitted applications to the committee for judging.
4. State chairs for Group A & B awards distributed award applications to their committees of District VPs for judging, using score card provided. Winning applications were sent to the State VP for Awards and Recognition.
5. District VPs sent letters congratulating award winners, with copies also being sent to their CED/DED. Letters were also sent to non-winning applicants.
6. Fifty-six plaques were ordered from Trophies and Tributes. 9 x 12 plaques were ordered for Past State President, Distinguished Service, Continued Excellence, and Florence Hall Award winners; other winners will receive 8 x 10 plaques. Non-member, Extension employee winners will receive framed certificates.
7. An email message was sent to all award recipients with information on the state awards presentation and encouraged them to invite their CED, DED, and guests to the Awards Banquet.
8. Summary statements were emailed, as an attachment, to the host district for publication in the State Meeting Program.
9. State award winners will be posted on the web after the State meeting. National and regional winners will be posted after the national meeting. North Carolina has individuals who will be recognized as national winners: 3 DSA recipients, 3 Continued Excellence recipients, National Winners in Florence Hall and New Professional, Southern Region Winner in Florence Hall and New Professional, 3<sup>rd</sup> place Southern Region winner in Communication – Radio.
