### **2011 Awards and Recognition Annual Report**

1. State Awards co-chairs and District Vice President were provided with description of responsibilities for awards and recognition via E-Mail. The membership was also advised of the change in awards submission dates via the NCEAFCS web page and emails to their membership by the District Vice Presidents.
2. District Vice-Presidents were asked to encourage member agents to plan for submitting awards as they were working on their end of year reporting.
3. Group A and B Awards chairpersons received information about awards judging process, state judging sheets, and awards information & national judging sheets from NEAFCS by email attachments.
4. Assisted NCEAFCS Webmaster in updating Awards information posted on the NCEAFCS web page.
5. Judging sheets, awards tally sheets, awards winners' sheets, and awards summary sheet are saved in electronic format and hard copy for future reference.
6. A judging sheet for the Ada Dalla-Pozza award was created.
7. State chairs for Group A & B awards distributed award applications to their respective committees of District Vice Presidents for judging, using the scorecard provided.
8. Scorecards were sent to the State Vice President of Awards & Recognition and eligible applications were forwarded to NEAFCS Awards and Recognition Chairperson for judging at National level.
9. Twenty-seven plaques were ordered from Trophies and Tributes: (4) 9 x 12 plaques for Past State President, Distinguished Service [2] and Florence Hall Awards; (13) 8 x 10 plaques for winners of Dean Don Felker Financial Management Award, Television Award, Radio Award [2], Written Press Release Award, Youth Award [2], Extension Housing Outreach Award, Early Career Award [3], Early Childhood Child Care Training Award, and Community Partnership Award; and (10) "7 x 9" plaques for Dean Don Felker Financial Management Award, Florence Hall Award [3], Early Childhood Child Care Training Award [5], and Community Partnership Award . Three framed certificates were also awarded for Dean Don Felker Financial Management Award, Community Partnership Award, and the Florence Hall Award.
10. All awards recipients received information about the state awards presentations from their District Vice President and were encouraged to invite their CED, DED, and guests for the Awards Banquet.
11. Summary statements were emailed, as an attachment, to appropriate state executive committee members for publishing in the state meeting program.
12. State award winners will be posted on the NCEAFCS website following the state meeting.

13. National winners will be posted after the NEAFCS meeting. North Carolina has four association members who will be recognized at the NEAFCS national meeting for five National and Regional awards. North Carolina has two National winners for the Distinguished Service Award, one 3<sup>rd</sup> place National winner for the Radio Award, one 2<sup>nd</sup> place Southern Region winner for the Radio Award and one third place Southern Region winner for the Television Award.

14. Prior year’s awards and recognition files have been placed in the NC State University Archives division of D.H. Hill Library on campus at North Carolina State University. They are filed in the Collection UA 102.056 under North Carolina Extension Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Records. The accession number is 2010-0084.
