**RE:** Spring Dairy Cattle Judging Clinic on Saturday April 23 at Correll Farms in Rowan County from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

We will hold a dairy cattle judging clinic for all 4-H youth, 4-H adult volunteers, FFA youth, and FFA/Voc. Ag. teachers on Saturday, April 23 at Correll Farms in Rowan County from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. We appreciate the Correll family for being willing to host this event again this year.

This clinic will be an excellent opportunity to help our more experienced youth judges sharpen their judging skills and also get younger members started in the basics of dairy judging. FFA/Voc. Ag. teachers and adult volunteers will also learn techniques to use when training judging teams. Mark your calendars now for Saturday, April 23 and plan to participate in our Spring Dairy Cattle Judging Clinic. **Please bring a clipboard, pencil and paper for taking notes.**

From Salisbury, NC: From I-85 South take the Jake Alexander Boulevard and go right at the top of the ramp. Travel Jake Alexander approximately 5 miles to Statesville Road (Hwy 70). Cross over and turn left onto Woodleaf Road. Travel to the second caution light (approx. 11 mi) this will bring you to Hwy 801. Turn left and travel 1/4 mile and turn right onto Short Road.

From Statesville, NC: Take Hwy 40E to Cool Springs exit 162. Go Right at top of ramp. Go to second road on left (Woodleaf/Cool Springs Rd, there is a Keaton's Chicken Sign). Turn left there. Stay on that road until you reach Woodleaf (there will be a caution light). Take a Right there (pass BP & Speedy Mart) then take the first road right, Short Rd.

From the Asheboro, NC area: Take Hwy 64 through Lexington then left onto 801.
