Accommodations

Registration Fee

The cost of this course is US \$1,450 per person if housed in double bed rooms, or US \$1,650 if housed in individual hotel rooms. It includes training, educational materials, local transportation, laboratory materials, t-shirt, lodging and all meals from May 14 to 18 (breakfast, lunch and snacks) EXCEPT the evening meals. The fee for Feed Manufacturing Short Course is \$ 400/500. This includes lodging (May 18-19) and meals EXCEPT dinners.
