About the Workshop

Beginning in 2005, WDC Agents are **required** to attend a Recertification Workshop every three years after attaining the basic certification. This workshop will discuss techniques used for wildlife damage control, present methods for the operation of a small business, and review laws and procedures for WDCA in North Carolina. At the end of the workshop, you must pass a closed-book examination to be recertified as a Wildlife Damage Control Agent.
