

## THE COMMITTEES' CHOICES

When the choices of all the panel members were compiled, it was found that 50 species in 36 genera were mentioned and that only 11 species had been mentioned more than once. This reflection of the diversity of the backgrounds and opinions of the panel members created a problem for METRIA with regards to the formulation of a list of recommended trees.

To condense the overall list to a more workable number, panel chairmen were asked to meet with their members and choose five **species** from **among** all their selections. These are the trees-that should **receive** the most attention in future trials.
