About the Workshop

Skillfully executed and well planned intermediate stand management can dramatically improve the economic value, aesthetics and wildlife habitat in a working forest. During the past decade, considerable advances have been made in our understanding of the effects of timber stand improvement treatments on future forest values and quality. Crop tree management can simultaneously improve wildlife habitat, enhance forest aesthetics, and produce high-value timber products.

Who Should Attend

All forest resource managers, consultants, landowners, and others who wish to learn how to enhance future forest quality and multiple forest values through active management will benefit from this workshop.
