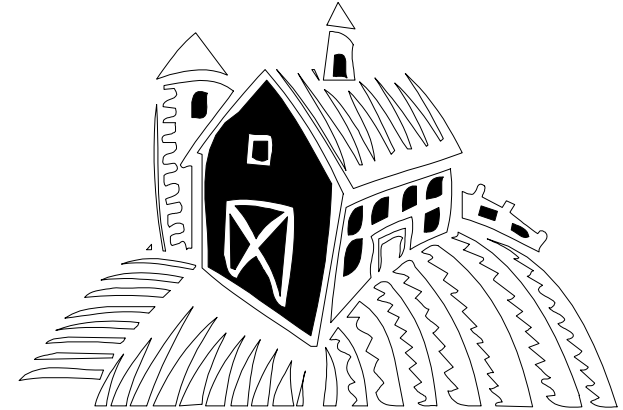

Life After Tobacco: Alternative Farm Opportunities

October 12, 2005 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM

Program

With recent changes in tobacco production and marketing and the federal buyout of tobacco quota, opportunities exist for tobacco quota owners to enter new enterprises. One such long-term enterprise is timber production. Timber can provide rewarding returns to landowners. Tobacco buyout payments can fund the transition into this alternative either by converting tobacco land to timber production or using the funds to purchase additional land that is in timber production.

Topics

- Productivity and value of timber - current versus potential
- Long-run investment returns - demand for product
- Tax implications - deferral of tax on buyout dollars, timber sales
- Timber income - as an investor or "in the business"
- Tobacco - the current vision of a future
