Tom Gerow, Jr. is a Staff Forester for the NC Division of Forest Resources, with 7 years prior experience in the forest products industry across three states, mostly focused on timber harvesting logistics. He is a N.C. Registered Forester and has a B.S. in Forest Management from NCSU.

Bill Swartley is Forest Hydrologist and Forestry Nonpoint Source Unit Manager for the NC Division of Forest Resources; he joined the Division in 1998. Previously, Bill was a Senior Scientist with Progress Energy's Environmental Services and a Regulatory Specialist with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' Nashville District. Bill has 25 years of experience in water quality monitoring, research and permitting.

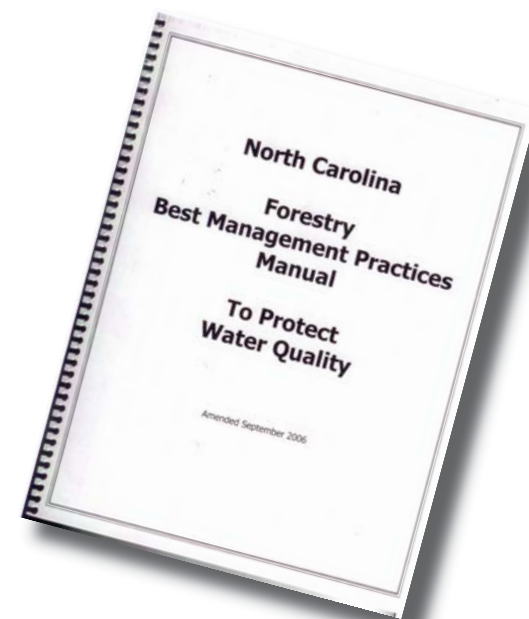
