4-H Summer Fun is a special program sponsored by Montgomery County 4-H through NC Cooperative Extension. Activities are open to all youth ages 5-19. (5 year olds must have completed kindergarten). Workshops are designed for specific age groups and there are limited spaces. (Please do not register your child for a class that is not for their age). We invite you to join us for a fun and exciting time. You do not have to be a 4-H member to participate.

To enroll in 4-H Summer Fun, you must complete a registration form, available at the 4-H office, along with a Code of Conduct, Medical Release and Photo Consent. Payment should be made at the time of registration. Make checks payable to Montgomery County 4-H. One registration form per participant, please.

Early Registration for current 4-H members will be on Wednesday, June 5th from 8am-5pm.

Early Registration for the public will be open on Thursday, June 6th from 8am-5pm. We will continue to accept registrations after this date until each workshop is full. Please take advantage of the early registration dates to ensure your child's space in the workshops of their choice.
