Pre-Conference sessions will be offered on Friday afternoon. Participants must register separately for this event. Note that there is an additional \$30 fee to participate in these sessions, and participants must pre-select the specific sessions in which they will participate on Friday afternoon. Registration rates are listed on the overview documents and include several registration options. Be sure to take a look at all of the registration options, but note that all registrations are due on the same day - January 17, 2014.


