



2013 U.S. Flue-Cured Crop

- Good prices in contracts...\$2.00 per pound +
- Prices received even higher\$2.15 per pound or more
- Yields down due to very wet season...2,024 pounds/acre
- Very short global supplies of flavor style, good quality fluecured


U.S., Brazil and Zimbabwe Flue-Cured Tobacco Production







Summary

- Global supplies of good quality flavor-style fluecured still short going into 2014 season
- Robust demand from China
- But...negative long-term demand factors remain
- Good weather in 2014 will likely mean another good year for U.S. flue-cured producers
