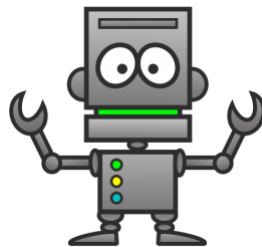

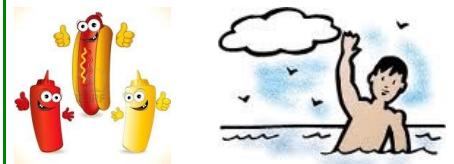

Policies & Procedures

All fees must be paid at the time of registration. All fees are non-refundable unless a class is cancelled. Refunds will be made in September. All returned checks will incur a \$25 processing fee. In the case of a returned check, class and processing fees should be paid in full, with cash, within two days of notice, or registration will be cancelled. Bladen County 4-H reserves the right to cancel classes in case of insufficient registrations.

Participants may be dropped off no more than 10 minutes prior to the beginning of the session. Punctuality of participants is expected, particularly in the case of field trips. The van/bus will wait a maximum of 10 minutes past the scheduled departure time.

Punctuality of parents/adults picking up youth following programs and activities is **mandatory**. Youth must be picked up at the time the program ends. If 4-H staff members are required to care for your child more than 15 minutes past the end of the program, your child will not be allowed to participate in other Summer Fun Activities.

There will be no transferring of registration among youth (i.e. if the youth who is registered cannot attend, their registration cannot be given to another child). In addition, no refunds will be given for youth who do not attend.

The confirmation you receive upon your registration will be your reminder. No reminder calls or letters will be sent.

4-H Data and Medical Release forms must be completed for each participant, **including health insurance information**. The Medical Release forms must be notarized. Participants can get a copy of this paperwork at the time of registration or by logging onto our website at <http://bladen.ces.ncsu.edu/>.

Parents and Guardians need to bring their photo ID and their health insurance information for each child to be registered.

In order to ensure the safety of your child, parents, please note that you will be required to sign your child in and out of every class. There is a place on the 4-H Data Form to designate authorized individuals who may sign out your child. Your child will not be released to anyone but those individuals listed.
