Directions From Extension Center to Stop #1:

South on S. Bickett Blvd./ US-401 toward Royal Community/Raleigh. At the stoplight at Royal, turn left onto MC Wilder Rd., then turn right onto Joe Denton Rd., turn left into farm path at 79 Joe Denton Road.

Directions From Stop #1 to Stop #2:

Travel back to Royal Crossroads, turning left onto 401 South, at the Harris Community Crossroads, turn right onto Tarboro Road, traveling into the city limits of Youngsville, with Wildwynn Stables on the right, 401 East Main Street, behind the daycare center.

Directions From Stop #2 to Stop #3:

Leaving Wildwynn, turn left onto Main Street/Tarboro Road, and at Hill Ridge Farm, turn left onto Mays Crossroads Rd., Sandy Hill Farm is on the right at 3017.

Directions From Stop #3 to Lunch, Extension Center:

At Sandy Hill, turn right onto Mays Crossroads Rd., travel several miles before turning onto Peach Orchard Road, until it merges with Hwy. 56 (W). At Hwy. 56, turn right and travel back into Louisburg. At the intersection w/ US 401 Hwy., turn left on Bickett Blvd.; after crossing the Tar River, and right before the 2nd stoplight, turn into the parking lot of the Extension Center (Ag. Building).
