VARIETIES AVAILABLE

RASPBERRIES: Self-Fertile

DORMAN RED - Rambling, very prolific. Large, deep red fruit. Ripens in late summer.

BLUEBERRIES: At least two varieties must be planted to ensure cross pollination.

BRIGHTWELL - Ripens mid-season over a long period; large fruit; excellent quality; very productive; growth is vigorous and upright.

CLIMAX - Ripens early over a short period; medium size berries with a sweet flavor. Growth is upright with an open spreading crown.

PREMIER - Ripens early to mid-season; very productive; vigorous growth; large fruit.

BLACKBERRIES: Self-Fertile

ARAPAHO - Thornless; erect-growing with medium fruit and good flavor. Ripens over a four week period. **TRIPLE CROWN** - Thornless; fruit is large and sweet; ripens later than most varieties.

MUSCADINES: Self-Fertile

COWART - Very large fruit, black in color, ripens early-mid season.

TRIUMPH - Large fruit, greenish-bronze color, ripens early-mid season.

BUNCH GRAPES: Self-Fertile

MARS - Blue grape, seedless, disease resistant, good flavor, high yield, ripens mid August.

FIG TREES: Self-Fertile

BROWN TURKEY - Bears twice a year with the flesh turning from various shades of amber to pink. The skin is copper-brown. Very hardy. Ripens early and late summer.

CELESTE - Skin is light brown to violet-brown, whitish pink color flesh and very few seeds. Ripens early summer.
