To: **Potential Livestock Exhibitors of the 2014 Coastal Carolina Ag Fair**

Thank you for your interest in exhibiting livestock in this year's fair. Enclosed are necessary forms for entry of livestock. In this packet, you should have:

1. **Official Pre-Entry Livestock Forms**
2. **Rules & Regulations for Livestock**
3. **Livestock Categories – Allowable Entries**

You will need to complete the Official Pre-Entry Livestock Form and **return to the Craven County Cooperative Extension office by 5:00 PM Friday, October 10, 2014**. We are requesting that you approximate delivery time, pick-up times and number of cages needed. This information will assist us in planning to care for your animal(s). A copy of the livestock categories is also enclosed. Please use name of the livestock and alpha-numeric code as it appears from this list to fill out the form. Please read and sign the Rules & Regulations for Livestock. We will need a signed copy of this prior acceptance of animals into the livestock area (sign and date at bottom of page). Minors should have parents sign the form.

LIVESTOCK RULES AND REGULATIONS

Procedure for exhibitors to follow in making entries for LIVESTOCK

1. LIVESTOCK ENTRIES: (see Livestock Division for complete list of Rules & Regulations for Livestock entries).

Application for livestock entries must be turned into the Craven County Cooperative Extension office by 5pm on Friday, October 10, 2014. Call the office at 633-1477 for details or download the information from <http://craven.ces.ncsu.edu/>. To check in livestock, go directly to the livestock barn.

- a) Livestock exhibitors must place POULTRY ONLY ENTRIES or POULTRY AND LIVESTOCK ENTRIES in the livestock Barn between 10:00am-6:00pm on Tuesday, October 21, 2014. Livestock exhibitors must place ALL OTHER LIVESTOCK (NO POULTRY) in the livestock barn between 10:00am-6:00pm on Wednesday, October 22, 2014. Entries should be halter broken and arrangements for the special needs should be made prior to entry.
- b) After any inspection of the animals, if said animal is found to be sick or diseased, it must be removed immediately and will not be eligible for any premium.
- c) All animals must be picked up MONDAY, November 3, 2014 between 10AM-6PM. Any exhibit removed prior to removal date will forfeit any premium awarded.
- f) Livestock will not be allowed into the livestock barn until inspected and passed by the health or veterinarian officials.
- g) Removal of livestock from pens or cages during fair operation hours is prohibited unless previously approved by the Craven County Jaycees Fair Association.
- h) Exhibitors with more than 20 livestock entries must deliver livestock by 2:00 PM on WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22, 2014.

2. All booth and individual exhibits must be removed Monday, November 3rd between 10AM-6PM. Any item not Removed will be forfeited. Any exhibit removed prior to removal date will forfeit any premium awarded.

3. Except in case of conflict, all general rules and regulations will apply in each department. Some rules are repeated for emphasis and others apply only to certain departments. Please pay close attention to the general rules at the beginning of each department's listing. In the event a situation is not specifically addressed by the premium book, the decision of the judges and fair management is final.

4. All entries must be raised, made or produced within the last year by residents or landowners of Craven, Carteret, Jones or Pamlico counties; or students attending school in one of the four counties.

5. The fair officials reserve the right to refuse any entry.

6. It is agreed that any exhibitor placing an entry in the Fair, will be bound by the rules of the fair.

7. Reasonable space will be allowed to exhibitors to display their entries. However, Fair officials can refuse entries due to space limitations.

8. In classes having only one entry, one premium will be awarded at the discretion of the judges. If the judges determine that the entry is not of exceptional quality, the judges reserve the right to award no premium.

9. The decision of the judges will be final and no appeal will be considered.

10. The officials of the fair will withhold premiums in any case where it appears that fraud or deception has been attempted.

- 11.** An exhibitor may not make more than one entry in each class. (Example: "B" is the department; "B-2" is the class).
- a. If there is no class listed for an item it can be entered in the class "OTHER".
 - b. There will be only 1 "OTHER" class for each department and each participant.

12. Youth entries will be designated by a "J" following the department.

13. Exhibits will be judged on Thursday, October 23rd at 9 am. The building will be closed while judging takes place.

- 14.** Every reasonable care will be taken to prevent damage to any exhibit, but the Fair officers and/or Cooperative Extension offices will not be responsible should damage or loss occur.
- 15.** Each exhibitor will receive FREE pass good for admission only.
- 16.** EXHIBITORS WITH MORE THAN 20 ITEMS FOR EXHIBITION, MUST ARRIVE AT LEAST 2 HOURS PRIOR TO CHECKOUT.

I have read, understand and will abide by the provisions as outlined above as well as other rules and regulations provided by the Coastal Carolina Ag Fair Premium Guide.

- *Minors must have signature of parent or guardian*



- **All animals must be in the livestock area between 12 Noon and 6 pm, Wednesday, October 22, 2014.**
- Large animal livestock (excluding sheep and goats) must be halter broken.
- Animals will be watered, fed, and cared for while at the fair. Owner should provide any special feeds or medications.
- Animals will be judged Thursday, October 23rd. Only judges are allowed in the livestock area at this time.
- **All animals must be picked up Monday, November 3rd between 10AM-6PM. Exhibitors with more than 20 entries must pick up livestock by 2:00 PM.**
- All poultry, where required by law, will be tested for pullorum typhoid prior to entry by a NCDA & CS agent. This expense will be borne by the Fair.
- All goats must be tagged with a USDA scrapie identification tag.
- Coggins Test (negative) documentation for Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) must be available for inspection for equine.
- Each exhibitor is limited to a total of 30 animal entries. Each exhibitor is limited to a total of 15 Poultry entries. (Example: An exhibitor can enter 30 total animals, only 15 of which can be poultry.)
