ENROLLMENT FORM

Please submit a copy of the **4-H Enrollment if you are new to 4-H** and have not completed one for your <u>club leader as of the deadline</u>. This form is only completed once in a 4-H'ers involvement, unless otherwise requested from the state office for events.

MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS

The **Medical Release** form must be updated annually. If you have not submitted an updated copy, please do so and make sure it is notarized. Remember, the Medical Release form is only good for one year, and without it you cannot attend any teen event.

LOCATION & FACILITIES

We will be staying at the Comfort Inn in Washington, NC (1636 Carolina Ave, Business Highway 17). Other activities will be held at the Washington Civic Center, Golden Corral, Beaufort Community College, and the Washington Yacht & Country Club.

COSTS

The \$85 registration cost covers the hotel, all activities, snacks and meals, breakfast (at Golden Corral and hotel), lunch and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast (at hotel) on Sunday. <u>You will need to have eaten</u> <u>dinner Friday before arriving at the Extension office.
