
- ✿ Each camp is age appropriate, PLEASE adhere to the specific age limits



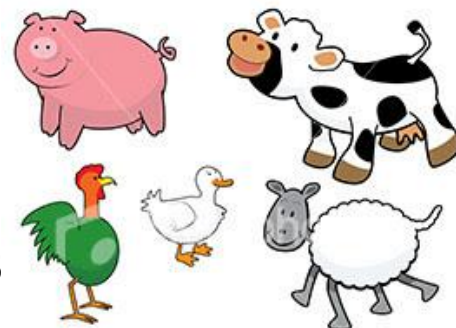


Farm Safety Day Camp
