Blueberries (At least two different varieties of blueberries must be planted to ensure cross-pollination in order to produce fruit.) \$8.00 (1 gallon)

- * Climax Early fruiting variety with upright growth habits and more of an open spreading crown than other varieties. Climax has been used for years in commercial, pick your own, and home settings. Berries are firm with excellent flavor, good color, and a very small stem scar.
- * Premier Ripen early to mid-season but usually earlier than other mid-season varieties. Fruit are larger in size with excellent color, great flavor and a dry stem scar. Plant growth is upright and vigorous. Great for hand picking.
- Brightwell Fruit ripens in early June through mid-July. Plants have very vigorous and upright growing characteristics. Variety is very reliable for fruiting. Harvest period is 35 days. Berries are medium size, excellent flavor, and a dry stem scar.



* Ouachita - Fruit are large in size, very good flavor, and an average sugar content of 10-11%. Fruit ripen mid-season over about five weeks with consistently high yields.



Pears \$25.00 (5 gallon)

* Moonglow - Large, attractive pear. Flesh is soft, smooth, nearly grit free and juicy with good flavor. Good pollinizer for other pears. Bears heavy at an early age. Very blight resistant.



Muscadines \$8.00 (1 gallon)

Nesbitt - Black; fruit are very large in size, cluster, high yields, ripen mid to late season, and a dry stem scar. Plants are very vigorous, disease resistant, and cold hardy. (2 year plant, bareroot)



* Tara - Bronze; fruit are large in size, good flavor, dry stem scar, and ripen early to mid-season. Plants are initially slow growing but become more vigorous after the first growing season, disease resistant, and cold hardy. (2 year plant, bareroot).

Fig Trees \$8.00 (1 gallon)

* Brown Turkey - Bears twice a year, with flesh turning from various shades of amber to pink. The skin is copper-brown. Very hardy. Ripens early to late summer.



Celeste - Fruit are small to medium in size, light brown to violet-brown skin, whitish pink color flesh and very few seeds. Ripens early summer.

Apples \$25.00 (5 gallon)

Honey Crisp -Fruit is mottled red over yellow with a very crisp flesh. Excellent eating and keeping apple. Annual bearer.



- **Granny Smith** Fruit are large in size, light green skin, white flesh, crisp, juicy, and ripens late. Tree growth is vigorous, bears fruit at a young age, and is a good pollinator.
- Gala Fruit are medium to large in size, golden skin with red striping, white flesh, crisp, good flavor, and ripens midseason. Tree growth habit is vigorous and upright.
- Fuji Fruit are medium in size, yellowish green with red tint skin, white flesh, very crisp, juicy, and ripens mid-season. Tree growth is vigorous and spreading.
