Burke County 4-H Summer Fun 2016

What is Summer Fun? 4-H Summer Fun is a special program offered by the NC Cooperative Extension, Burke Center 4-H Program. 4-H Summer Fun is open to all youth ages 5 to 18 (5-year olds must have completed kindergarten). Membership in 4-H is not required. This brochure describes all programs offered. These events or activities are operating under the 4-H Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure. You can obtain a copy from the 4-H office. This 4-H Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure is a condition of participation in any North Carolina 4-H activities or programs.



Registration Will be held May 26, 2016 3-6 pm at The Burke Agricultural Building



Registration is on a first come, first served basis, as spaces are limited. A one-time registration fee of \$10.00 is charged per participant. Fees include limited accident insurance, snacks, supplies, entrance fees, T-shirt and transportation when applicable. 4-H Scholarships are available on a limited basis. Contact the 4-H office for more information. Checks should be made payable to Burke County 4-H. NO registrations will be made over the telephone, but we will be happy to answer any questions you have.

After May 26, 2016 registration must be completed in person at the Extension Office – Monday through Friday from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm until classes are filled.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

Punctuality: Children may be dropped off no earlier than **15 minutes prior** to the start of each activity and picked up no later than **15 minutes after** the activity is scheduled to end. If your child is picked up after that 15 min time, a fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed. Please contact the Extension office if an emergency occurs that will prevent you from picking up your child on time. In the event that a returning trip is delayed, parents will be notified as early as possible.

<u>Attire:</u> Children <u>must</u> wear tennis shoes and socks for each activity. <u>No flip-flops or sandals</u> allowed. Special instructions will be given for appropriate clothing for each activity. Please help dress your child accordingly.

<u>Car Seat Information:</u> If your child is under 8 years of age and less than 80 pounds, parents are required to provide a child safety seat for their child.

Lunch: Unless otherwise stated you will need to provide your child with a bag lunch and drink for each activity. Please be sure that all lunches can be kept in a cooler and consumed without being heated.

Chaperones: Summer Fun activities are limited to registered youth and NC Cooperative Extension staff only.

Refunds/Cancellations: All fees are **non-refundable** unless an event is cancelled. Refunds for cancellations will be made in August. In the event of a cancellation, you will be notified as soon as possible. Cancellations due to bad weather will not be rescheduled.

<u>Special Needs:</u> Persons with disabilities and persons with limited English proficiency may request accommodations to participate by calling the Burke County Extension Office at **828-764-9480** at **least 15 days prior** to the scheduled activity. Any additional costs incurred, such as admission fees will need to be paid by the parent or guardian.
