July 14, 2016 - 9:00 a.m.– 12:00 p.m.

Kids will get use to the needle and thread as well as the up and down motion of hand sewing. Once mastered, the kids will make several fun projects they can take home. Closed-toe shoes required. Bring your own small snack. **Cost is \$10.**

Junior Master Gardener Summer Camp

Ages *9-13

Youth will learn the importance and uses of plants, plant classification, parts, needs, growth, processes and propagation. Extension Master Gardeners will team with the Urban Horticulture agent to bring this hands-on learning opportunity that will focus on nature and science. Classes will be held every Friday beginning on June 17th through August 5th at the Cape Fear Botanical Gardens. Snacks, water station, and supplies for projects are supplied. Closed-toe shoes are required. Bring your own lunch. Bring/wear hat and towel. **Cost is \$ 125. Limit 25**

Model Aviation

June 21, 2016 - 9:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

Ages *9-14

Participants will build free flight gliders and visit a remote controlled airfield and fly and remote controlled plane with the help of an instructor. Youth will learn about airplanes and aerospace engineering through hands-on activities. Closed-toe shoes required. Bring your own lunch. **Cost is \$10.**

Youth will visit NC State University and a local farm over the course of two days of fun, hands-on learning modules. Lunch and snack will be provided both days. **Cost is \$30.**

Farm to Kitchen Kids Day Camp

This camp will allow kids to visit local farms to see where food is grown and harvested. Participants will learn how to cook some of the delicious bounties for lunch. Closed-toe shoes are required. Individualized Youth Sewing Classes

Youth will learn basic sewing skills about the sewing machine, following a pattern guide sheet, and complete a simple project. If youth have their own sewing machine, please bring with you. If not, sewing machines will be provided. Time slots available are 9:00 a.m.-10 a.m., 10:15 a.m.-11:15 a.m., and 11:30 a.m.-12:30 a.m. (Only 2 youth per time slot on a first come, first serve basis) Once registered, you will receive additional information. Youth will need to bring a basic sewing kit. Closed-toe shoes are required.

Cost is \$5. Limit: 6 per week

- ◆ Medical Release Forms must be signed by the parent or guardian and notarized.

- ◆ Registration is open until class is full. Slots are limited. Register early.
- ◆ Closed-toe shoes required for all activities.
- ◆ Fees will be refunded only if the class is cancelled or rescheduled by Extension staff.
