IMPORTANT INFORMATION



- ✱ **To Register your child for 4-H Summer Adventures**
 - Complete enclosed Registration form.
 - Complete 4-H Enrollment, Medical Release (can be notarized in the 4-H office) and Vehicle Waiver forms.
 - Initial Media Release on bottom of enrollment form.
 - Your child must initial the bottom of the enrollment form indicating their understanding of 4-H Code of Conduct.
 - Return forms with payment (check or money order – made payable to Guilford County 4-H.) Registration is NOT complete without payment. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE!!
- ✱ Guilford County 4-H invites you and your family to **join us in our ongoing community service project** and bring 2 non perishable food items (no glass please) for each camp you sign up for. All items are donated to the Greensboro Urban Ministry.
- ✱ **Please help us ensure a safe learning environment for everyone:**
 - *Please review the 4-H Code of Conduct and the 4-H Dress Code with your child.*
 - *Please adhere to the specific age limits. Age limits are set reflecting developmental comprehension activities.*
 - *Please speak directly to Peggie/Sadie, if your child has any allergies. Also indicate on medical release form.*
 - *Parents/Guardians are asked to enter the building to sign campers in and out each day.*
- ✱ **Camp drop off and pick up is at the Guilford County Agricultural Center at 3309 Burlington Road, Greensboro**
 - Enter the building at the Flag Pole.
 - Please ensure campers arrive and are picked up on time.
 - The building opens at 8 and closes at 5 pm.
- ✱ Camps are offered on a first come, first serve basis and space is limited.
- ✱ 4-H members can use their scholarship certificates for Summer Adventures. 4-H'ers must contact Tanya Gold, GC 4-H VLA treasure, to issue a check before registration is complete.

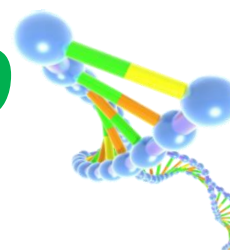

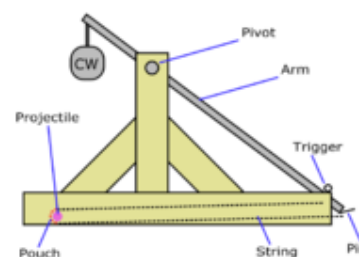
