There are two registration options this year. Full Time Registration (including Facility, Insurance, Saturday Lunch, Workshops (Saturday & Sunday), Saturday Dinner, Saturday Evening Activity, Lodging, and Sunday Breakfast is \$140 per youth (lodging 4 per room) and \$170 per adults (lodging 2 per room). Due to space, we cannot accommodate single rooming requests. Saturday Only Registration (including Facility, Insurance, Saturday Lunch, Saturday Workshops, Saturday Dinner and Saturday Evening Activity is \$95 per person. We will also be offering t-shirts for the conference for an additional charge of \$15 per person.

Registration should be submitted to our office no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, October 3, 2016. We will provide transportation to and from Raleigh from our extension office for individuals attending both camps.
