2016 4-H Rabbit and Chicken Show

RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Show Rules:

- 1. You must be between the ages of 5-19. Entry form must be filled out in order to participate. Due: November 28th.
- 2. Each child is allowed to enter one open rooster, one open hen, and/or one open rabbit.
- 3. All animals must arrive on show day in a cage suitable for carrying.

Open Rabbit and Chicken Show:

- 1. Animals may be of any type or breed.
- 2. Exhibitors will be responsible for providing their own shelter for their animal(s), as well as keeping their shelters clean.
- 3. Exhibitors are responsible for providing appropriate feed and water to their animal(s).
- 4. All animals must be free of apparent illness, disease, and parasites. Youth not complying may be asked to remove their animal from the premises.
- 5. Each poultry entry will be blood tested on the morning of the show, or must show proof of prior blood testing by an NCDA professional.
- 6. Entries will be judged based on breed standards. The awards given will be:
 - a. 5-19 years of age:
 - i. First, Second and Third Place in Age Category–Ribbons
 - ii. Best of Show Overall Trophy (Rabbit, Rooster, & Hen)
- 7. Youth will also participate in a showmanship class. Each entry in these classes will be judged and will receive awards as follows:
 - b. Youth Ages 5-8
 - i. Participation Ribbons
 - c. Youth Ages 9-18
 - i. First, Second and Third Place in Age Category–Ribbons
 - ii. Grand and Reserve Champion Poultry Showman Trophies
- 8. The Open Rabbit and Chicken Show will take place before lunch on the day of the show.
