
- 2 Type your county's name at the top of the spreadsheet.

Rather, separate parts with semicolons. Ex: For the question "Name 3 parts of the horse's hoof," format your answer as: 1) frog; 2) toe; 3) heel; 4) bars; 5) sole; etc.
