4-H PRESENTATIONS & PUBLIC SPEAKING

This competition allows youth the opportunity to present information by demonstration or illustrated talk for competition. The time limit is generally between 5 and 12 minutes, with specific time regulations in specific categories. This competition is an excellent opportunity for youth to build their confidence, knowledge, and public speaking skills. Each county determines how 4-H'ers are selected to compete at district competition.
