- 1) 2017 Awards & Recognition Plan of Work was updated to reflect 2017 deadlines for submission and judging. A timeline was added to the Plan of Work to make user friendly for District VPs and Group A & B Chairs.
- 2) NC Award Applications and Judging Sheets were updated to reflect current requirements and judging criteria.
- 3) DSA and Continued Service Award Judging Sheets were updated to reflect NEAFCS requirements and judging criteria.
- 4) NC Procedures Handout was revised and posted to NCEAFCS webpage.
- 5) Awards & Recognition Mid-Year Report was reviewed during January 13, 2017 board meeting conference call. The report was emailed to webmaster for posting to webpage.
- 6) Google Drive folder was created for all Awards and Recognition documents. This folder was shared with the Awards & Recognition Committee.
- 7) 21 Award applications were submitted by members – 4 Team Awards & 17 Individual Awards. 20 Acrylics/Crystals will be given out at the August 17th awards banquet for the 18 award winning applications (one team award included three NCEAFCS members). Second place winners and team members that are not members of NCEAFCS will receive a certificate during the awards ceremony. Acrylics/Crystals were ordered from Crown Trophy and Awards of Raleigh. Letters were emailed to first place award winners and second place award winners.
- 8) First and Second place winners were submitted for judging at the national level. Ten awards were submitted for NC. National winners were released to State VPs. NC had two Southern Region Second Place Winners and two DSA Award Winners that will be recognized at the National Meeting in Nebraska in 2017.
- 9) Award winner names were released to Director of Extension, Director of County Operations and District Directors.
- 10) Awards Information was emailed to Southeast District annual meeting committee members for printing in the awards program or annual meeting program (Southeast District makes the decision to print with annual meeting program or as an awards program).
- 11) State award winners will be posted on the NCEAFCS website following the annual meeting.
