NCDA&CS Hurricane Florence Disaster Assistance Program: (Includes Nursery Production for container plants less than 1 gallon to field grown plants 4" or greater)

The NCDA&CS announced a Hurricane Florence Agriculture Disaster Assistance Program on Monday, November 5. The NCDA&CS press release can be found here. The NCDA&CS Agricultural disaster program website has instructions for application and the online application. Some highlights are:

- Funding is dependent upon the North Carolina legislature.
- Signup period is November 7 December 10.
- You can request an extension if survival is not immediately known.
- Growers must complete signup online.
- Crop loss must be in a county declared a FEMA disaster county or USDA Secretarial declaration.
- Only one application per county, per tax identification number. If you experienced loss in multiple counties, separate applications must be submitted per county.
- You will need your Form 578 from FSA or a summary of loss with map and physical address or crops not reported on this form. (A late filing fee may be incurred for previously unreported crops. Please check with your local FSA office for more information.)
- You will need a completed W-9.
- You can apply even if you did or did not apply for other assistance programs.
