- 2. Registration will begin at Warren County 4-H Summer Palooza Block Party on Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. located at North Carolina Cooperative Extension, Warren County Center, 158 Rafters Lane, Warrenton, NC 27589. At this time, registration for the program must be in person. After June 7, 2018, registration will occur Monday Friday, 8:30 a.m. 5:00 p.m. Please be prepared to spend 15-20 minutes to complete the registration process.
- 3. Registration is on a FIRST PAID-FIRST RESERVED basis. All others will be placed on a waiting list. Please note all deadlines listed for each class. An annual insurance one-time fee of \$1 per participant is required in addition to the class fee. Payment is required at registration.
- 4. Cash/checks are accepted!! Limited scholarship may be available. Make checks payable to Warren County 4-H.
- 5. Refund will not be given unless a class is canceled by NC Cooperative Extension, Warren County Center.
- 6. Unless otherwise stated, classes will meet at the NC Cooperative Extension, Warren County Center.
- 7. Youth should wear clothing that is comfortable for lots of movement and can get dirty!! Closed-toe shoes are highly recommended!
- 8. We reserve the right to suspend your child from the program without refund should he/she become disruptive or violate the 4-H Code of Conduct in any way. If a child must be dismissed from the program, then the parent/guardian will be called to pick up the child immediately.
