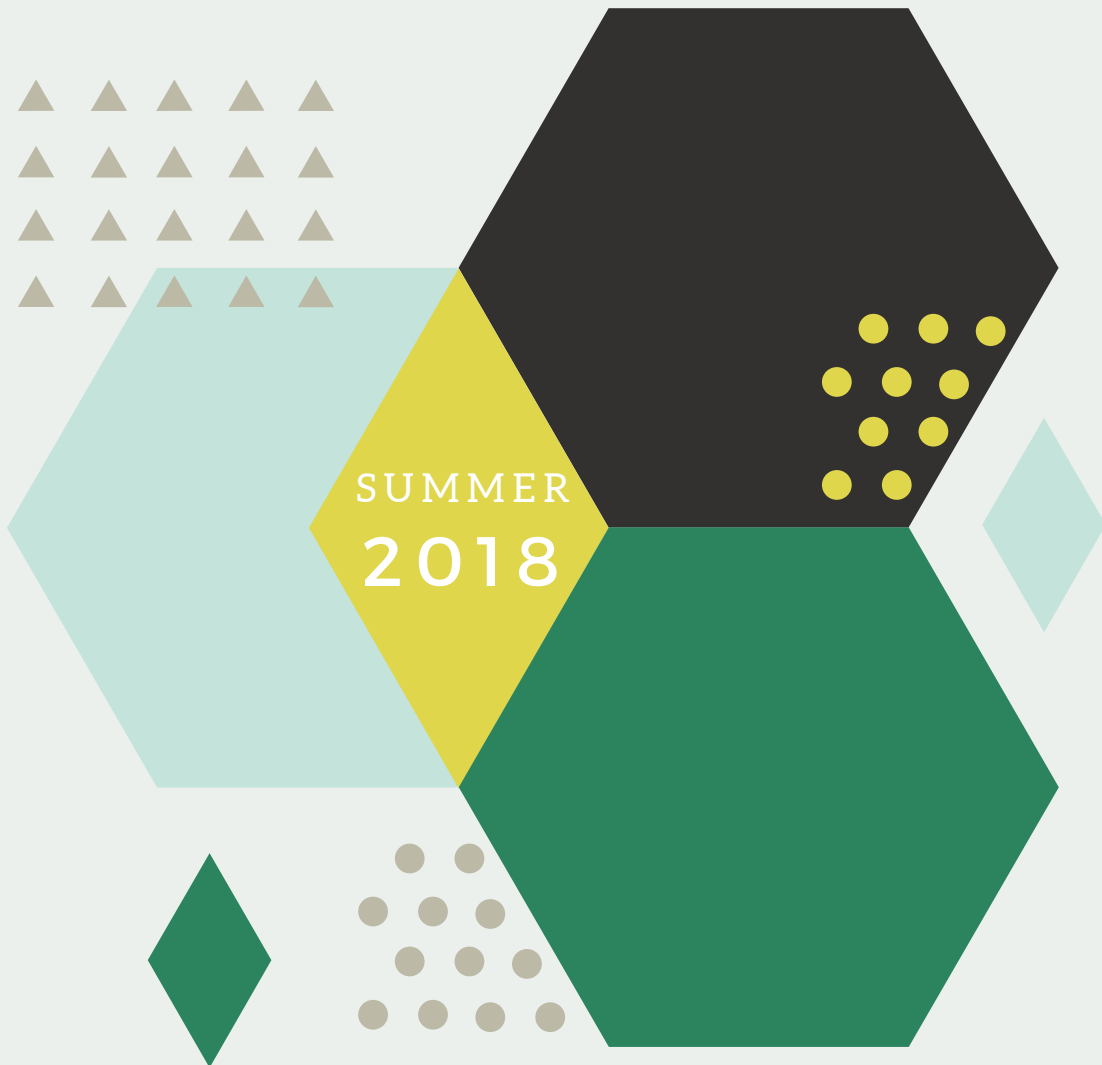

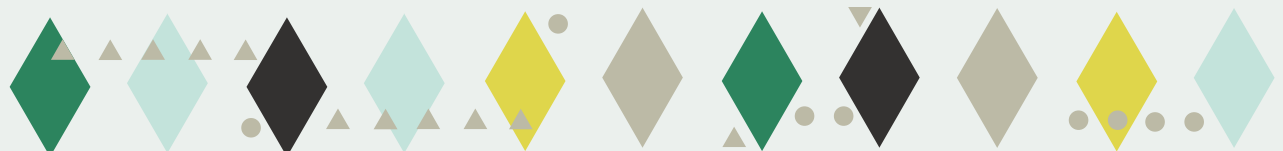

NC 4-H CONGRESS RALEIGH, NC

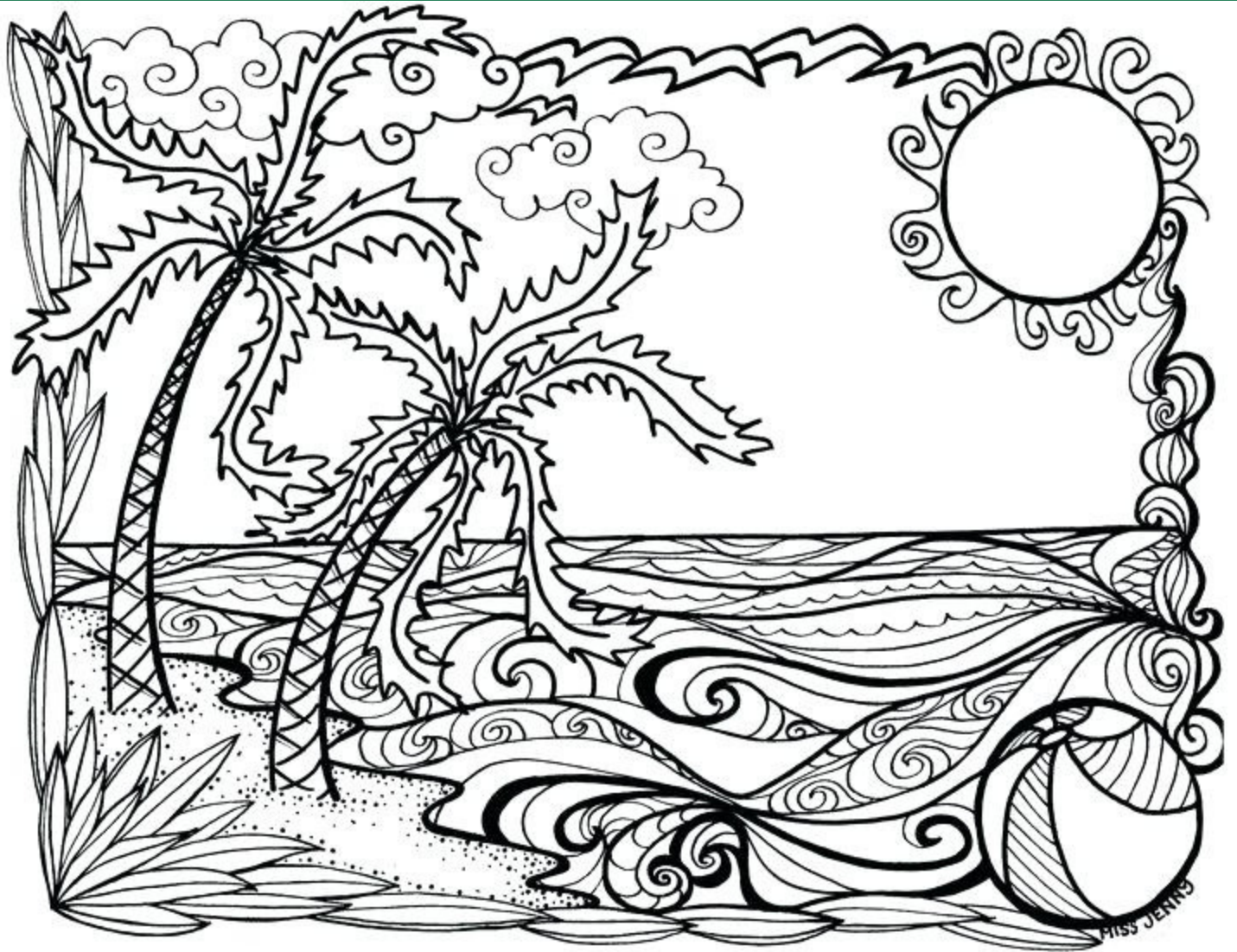
Six Tyrrell County youth attended NC 4-H Congress in Raleigh, NC, July 21-24th.

Sam Clough represented Tyrrell County at this year's NCACC Youth Voice in Hickory, NC, August 24-25th.

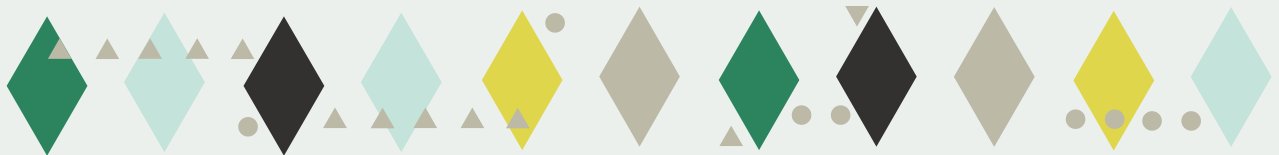

CLUBS

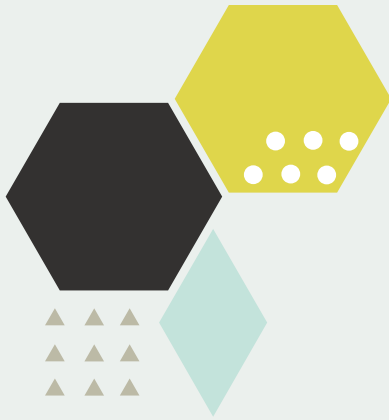
