This scholarship was established by the Rockingham County Cattlemen's Association (RCCA) in 2019. Initial funding is being provided by the RCCA members through Lifetime Membership dues, Platinum Level Corporate Sponsorship, and various fundraising projects. At the present time scholarships are awarded in \$500 increments, depending upon the number of applicants and availability of funds.

Mr. Ray Styer was an avid cattleman and land conservationist. He promoted no-till planting, crop rotation, and he was a firm believer in the farmer's responsibility to care for the land. This scholarship is named in memory of him and to honor the work that he did on his farm and in Rockingham County. The Cattlemen's Association wants to support the educational pursuits of the next generation of agriculturalists and conservationists in his memory.

Eligibility

- Graduating seniors from any of the high schools in Rockingham County or current college students from Rockingham County pursuing a baccalaureate or associate degree.
- Priority will be given to applicants who are pursuing a degree in agriculture with the intent of a career in agriculture. If not met, this <u>does not</u> disqualify the candidate.
- Priority will be given to current FFA and/or 4-H members. If not met, this <u>does not</u> disqualify the candidate.

- Leadership and extracurricular activities
- Personal motivation and initiative
- Demonstrated interest in the beef industry
- Career goals
- Academic standing
