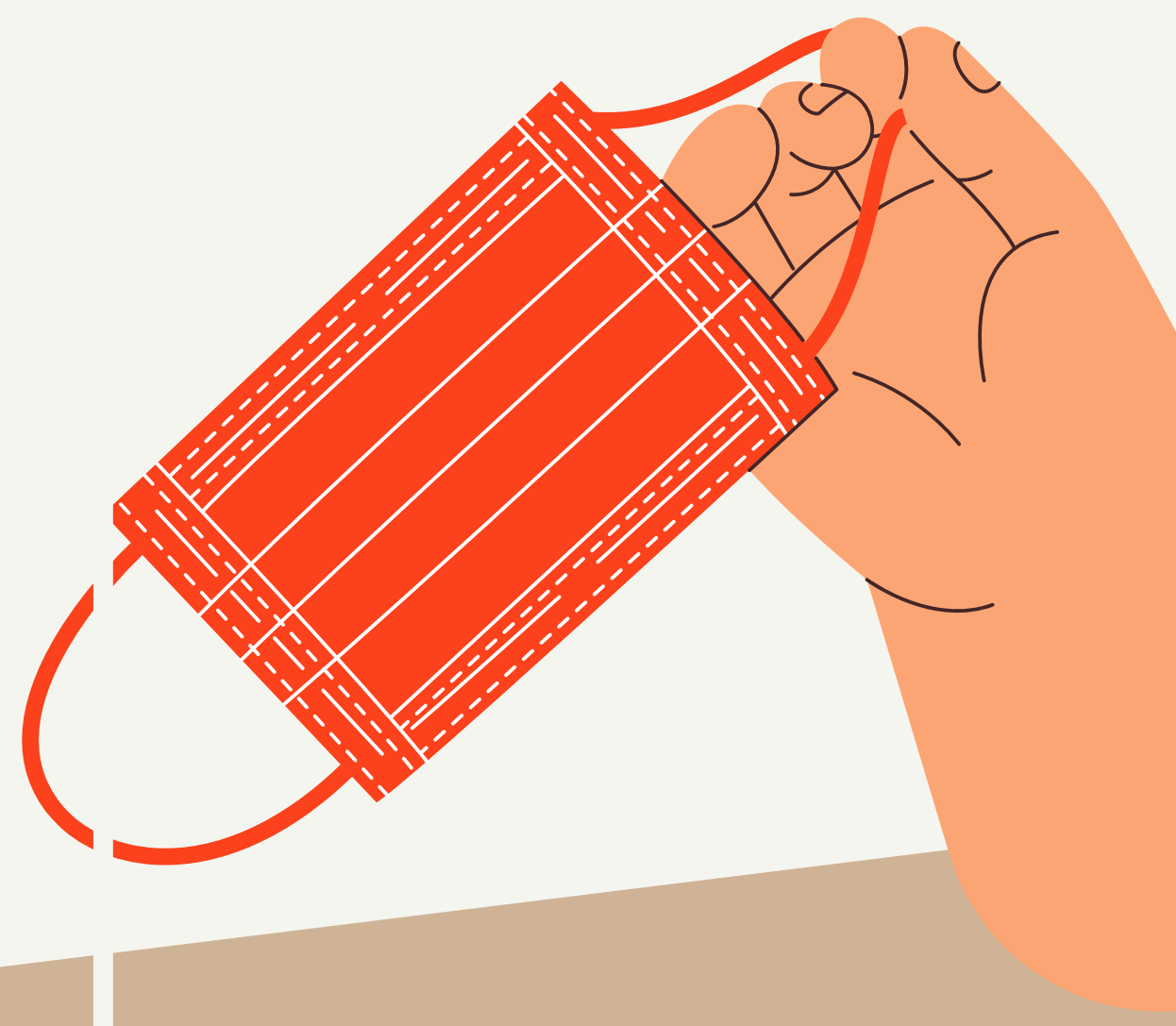

How to disinfect after a Covid-19 diagnosis.



Vocabulary words

CLEAN: use soap and water to reduce germs, dirt, and impurities on surfaces. It doesn't kill germs, only reduces the number of germs on a surface.

DISINFECT: use EPA-approved chemicals to kill germs on surfaces. This is intended to be done after cleaning. **You must follow the label instructions.**

1) Wear clean gloves and a mask.

2) Make sure you clean and disinfect hard surfaces such as counters, tabletops, doorknobs, faucets, bathroom fixtures, and bed frames.

3) Always follow the manufacturer's instructions, especially on how long you should leave the product on the surface.

"DISINFECTION IS NOT INSTANTANEOUS!"

4) To clean soft surfaces, follow the directions for those specific materials. If you can launder them, use the warmest setting appropriate.

Electronic Devices

Remove visible dirt from cellphones, tablets, touch screens, remote controls & keyboards. If you can't find the cleaning guidance for the device, **the CDC advises using alcohol based wipes or a 70% alcohol spray to disinfect. Dry thoroughly.**
