## **PESTICIDE SCHOOL & EXAMS**

There will be a two-day Pesticide Safety School in Plymouth at the Vernon James Center at 8:30AM February 15th - 16th. The exam will be at 1:00 PM on Feb. 16th. You MUST register in advance for both the school <u>and</u> the exam.

## **AUXIN TRAINING**

There are <u>two options</u> for auxin training this year. Both options will get you the required training plus 1 hour of X, N, D, & O pesticide credit.

<u>OPTION 1:</u> Attend a training on Zoom on one of the dates in the table below.
 I will be emailing out a registration link and passcode soon. Like last year, you will be required to register before attending.

# PARAQUAT TRAINING

If you plan to use paraquat in 2022, make sure you are up to date on your mandatory paraquat training. This training needs to be completed every 3 years, so if you have completed it since 2020, you're good to go.

I have no way to see who has taken the training online, so make sure you keep track of your login information and a record of when you last took the exam! If you are unable to complete the exam online or cannot remember if you took the training, please let me know and I can arrange for you to take a pencil & paper exam.
