

2022 Summer Fun Madison County 4-H



4-H is the youth development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. Madison County 4-H offers Summer Fun – a series of educational camps designed to build *life skills* through shared experiences and handson learning. **Youth must be 5 to 18 years of age as of January 1, 2022.** Follow the **3** easy steps to register:

4-H Summer Fun Registration

The following are required, without exception, for 4-H Summer Fun Registration

- **1. Before Camp Registration:** Enroll as 4-H member (not participant) at **v2.4honline.com** (includes health form, emergency contact, program liability waiver, photo, and transportation release, which covers 4-H membership for the rest of the year).
- 2. Register for camps beginning Monday, April 25th from 5:00-6:30pm, in-person at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center. Registration will be first-come, first-served and will continue during normal office hours from 8:00-4:30 on weekdays from April 26 June 1 or until camps are full.
- **3.** Please bring cash or check payable to *Madison County 4-H*. Payment for camp fees is due in full at time of registration to cover insurance and supplies. Waitlists do not require payment up front, but will be due if a space opens and you accept.

Learn your way around the kitchen as you are introduced to food safety, knife safety, and kitchen tools. We'll learn how to prepare yummy fruits and veggies that are grown locally. Participants will learn to read and follow recipes while preparing their own lunch each day.

Animal Science Camp June 13-16 (Mon-Thurs) | 9:00am-12:00pm | Ages 9-13 | \$50

Join us for a week of farm tours around the county and end with horseback riding at Sandy Bottom Trail Rides! You'll get lots of hands-on experience learning about sheep, goats, cattle, horses, and other farm animals! Drop-off and pick up is at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center each day; educational programs are off-site.



Launch into summer with the most exciting reactions of science! Our youngest campers will have fun discovering the wonders of biology, chemistry, and physics with common household items. We will have fun exploring Blannahassatt Island on the last day (Drop-off and pick-up at the Madison County Cooperative Extension Center). Morning snacks are provided.

Residential 4-H Camp at Betsy-Jeff Penn June 19-24 | Ages 8-12 | \$500*

Participants travel to Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Educational Center in Reidsville to spend the week learning about and enjoying the outdoors! Activities include swimming, canoeing, hiking, horseback riding, archery, climbing wall, and ropes course. The county's Extension 4-H Agent attends with campers to provide a seamless experience — especially for the first time camper! Transportation, meals, lodging, snacks, souvenir t-shirt, instruction, and insurance is provided in the cost. *Payment can be made in installments.

We'll explore gravity reactions, optical illusions, and learn the cool science of magic! Plus, you'll get to write with invisible ink, learn the secret behind the famous table cloth trick, and discover many more fantastic magic tricks and famous magicians. You'll be ready to WOW your friends and family with a magic show on the last day of camp!

Cloverbuds Explore Outdoors July 11-12 (Mon-Tues) | 9:00am-12:00pm | Ages 5-8 | \$15 Join us on an expedition through the forest as we take a closer look at the habitats and wildlife of the southern Appalachians! Kids as Chefs July 18-21 (Mon-Thurs) | 9:00am-1:00pm | Ages 9-13 | \$80

We will begin with a trip to Ingles to buy groceries, incorporating food selection and budgeting skills. We'll explore foods that are grown locally by making farm visits and talking with growers, then using fresh produce to prepare lunch together! Kids will get to make their own lunch each day, practicing a variety of our chefs' favorite techniques!

Learn how to grill all your favorite summertime fare! Youth will get to learn on charcoal and gas grills, and practice selecting and preparing different cuts of meat and seasonal veggies. Participants will learn grill safety and food safety. Wear comfortable clothes for being outside and closed-toe shoes, such as sneakers (NO crocs)

Registration Policies:

- NO phone, email, fax, or mail-in registration will be accepted.
- All registration fees are *non-refundable*, unless a class is cancelled.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without member enrollment at v2.4honline.com.
- Camp spaces will *not* be held without payment.
- Returned checks result in \$30 charge.
- If your child is placed on a waitlist, payment will be due if a space opens and you accept.

Additional Information:

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Please keep track of which camps your child has registered for. You may receive an email the week before the camp begins, containing additional reminders. Do not rely on this as a reminder.
- Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing for "away" trips, due to schedules established with our volunteers and partnering organizations.
- Due to NC law, 4-H staff are <u>not allowed to supply or install car seats</u>. If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place it in the County van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in a labeled container for the leader to be responsible for.
