ABGA Show Entry Fees: Youth Show Entry Fee: Pen Fees: Camper Hookups:	\$30/head for each show, or \$65/head to compete in all 3 shows. \$10 per head for Youth Market Wethers and Commercial Breeding Does. Showmanship competition is free. \$12 per 5' x 5' pen, includes 1 bag of pine shavings for bedding. Available for \$25 per night.

ABGA-Sanctioned Show Entries

- Exhibitors must comply with ABGA Show Rules.
- No limit on number of entries per farm for ABGA-Sanctioned Shows.
- All entries and payments should be made online via Showman.app.
- Additions and substitutions will be permitted until show day, but changes must be made via Showman.app prior to check-in.

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health papers) dated within 30 days of show are required for all animals being transported into NC from other states.
- Animals are subject to visual health inspection on the grounds. Those animals showing signs
 of illness will be barred from entry.

Youth Show Entries

- Open to youth 21 years of age and younger as of April 6, 2024.
- Exhibitors must be capable of showing animals without assistance in the show ring.
- Meat Goat Kids: Only wethers less than 1 year of age with all baby teeth and weighing 35 pounds or more are eligible to compete. Wethers must be castrated and fully healed. Goats will be weighed at check-in and assigned to classes accordingly. Should an exhibitor have more than one entry assigned to a particular weight class, another youth may show that animal for the exhibitor.
- Commercial Breeding Does: Non-registered does only. Does shown in the ABGA-Sanctioned Shows are <u>not</u> allowed to compete.
- All entries and payments should be made online via Showman.app.
- Addition and substitutions will be permitted, but changes must be made via Showman.app prior to check-in.
- Pens (5' x 5') bedded with 1 bag of pine shavings are available for \$12 each and must be prepaid. Although not recommended, youth will be permitted to show their animals from the trailer.
- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health papers) dated within 30 days of show are required for all animals being transported into NC from other states.
- Animals are subject to visual health inspection on the grounds. Those animals showing signs
 of illness will be barred from entry.
