2024 Alexander County 4-H Summer Opportunities for Youth

Kids in the Kitchen-Chopped: June 11th-13th
Time: 9am-3pm Ages: 9-14 years old Cost: \$75
Skills:

- Food Safety
- Knife Skills
- Measuring
- Meal planning

Objectives:

Participants will be trained the first two days on culinary skills to prepare them for the "chopped" competition on the last day. Like Chopped Shows, participants will compete in teams of 4 for three rounds-no elimination. Each round will have a mystery basket with items that must be incorporated into their dish. Each dish is judged on appearance, taste, and creativity. Participants have access to items in the pantry list and the equipment available. Participants must plan and prepare a dish with basket items, and finish cleaning up their station within the allotted time.
