Instructions:

 - b. Select Project: 4-H New Member Guide: Summer Fun Camps Madison
 - c. Answer "About You" Questions
 - d. Complete Health Form
 - e. Sign Acknowledgements & Consents
 - f. Confirm & Submit
- 3. You will get an email saying your registration has been submitted; You will get another email once your enrollment has been reviewed and approved.

4-H Summer Camp Registration Opens Tuesday, April 23rd at 6:00pm in 4-H Online

- 1. Login to 4-H Online you should land on the Member List Page.
 - Do NOT click to view your child's individual profile
- 2. From the Family Member List Page Click Events (left tab).
- 3. Register for each camp:
 - a. Click "Register" under the camp's image
 - b. Click the child's name to register, then click "Select"
 - c. Click the registration line, then click "Start Registration"
 - d. If spaces are available:
 - Click Pay by Check, then confirm, then next...
 - Click the Green Finish Button!
 - e. If the camp is full, you will get an error message. "Could not register..."
- 4. To get on the wait list when a camp is full:
 - Go back to the Event image for the camp
 - Copy wait list registration link and paste into a new tab in your browser.
 - Complete the Google form for wait list registration.

- 1. Payment must be made in full by Monday, April 29th at NOON (or within 3 business days of registration confirmation).

Registration Policies

- Registration is ONLY in 4-H Online (NO phone, email, fax, or mail-in registration will be accepted)
- Assistance with 4-H Online registration is available by appointment Monday-Friday 8:00am-4:30pm
- Camp spaces will be dropped if payment is not received by stated deadline. Returned checks result in \$30 charge.
- If your child is on a wait list, payment will only be due if a space opens and you accept.

Attendance Policies

- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
 We are not able to offer refunds for withdrawals or missed camps.
- Please keep track of which camps your child has registered for. You may receive an email the week before the camp begins, containing additional reminders. Do not rely on this as a reminder.
 Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing
- for "away" trips, due to schedules established with our volunteers and partnering organizations.

 Due to NC law, 4-H staff are not allowed to supply or install car seats. If a car seat or booster seat is needed, please provide one and place it in the County van. Your child's safety is very important to us!
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply medication in original container, with authorization form, for the leader to be responsible for.
