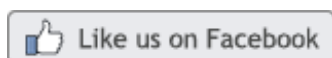

Country Superstars 102.3 is hosting this VIRTUAL FAIR, showcasing the hard work of local FFA and 4H members this year. Entrants simply record a video of you and your project/exhibit, describing all you want us to know about it's origin, the work you've put into it, and how it's been improved since you began working on/with it. Start the video by introducing yourself and be sure to include the name of your community and your school. Upload your video to youtube, and be sure the Youtube location is accessible to the public. Videos should be no longer than two minutes. Feel free to submit multiple projects, with a separate entry for each.

The virtual fair will be promoted heavily on Country Superstars 102.3, and all complete submissions will be featured on this page, accessible at countryss.com. Listeners will be encouraged to view participants' videos, and some may be shared on our station Facebook page.

Entries will be posted as received, and the fair will be accessible to the public starting Monday, September 28th, 2020 and LIVE online until October 25th, 2020.
