Does your child love competition? Are you wanting your child to develop their public speaking skills? Does your child have a unique talent that they want to share? If so, they should participate in Rowan County 4-H County Activity Day!

All 4-H Presentation (public speaking) participants will be scheduled to present via Zoom on April 19-21.

Those who plan to do 4-H Talent will submit a pre-recorded video for competition. **The video is due no later than April 9.**

If you are interested in Outdoor Cookery, we will schedule a separate time for you to compete in-person at the Extension office. Please note that District Outdoor Cookery presentations will be held in-person on June 25 at the Rowan County Extension office. State level Outdoor Cookery qualifiers will compete in-person this fall.

Rowan County Pullet Project



What is the Pullet Project?

The Rowan County Pullet Project is an opportunity for youth (ages 5-18 as of January 1) to learn more about the livestock industry. Through this project, youth will raise laying hens. In September, youth will participate in a pullet show, where they will demonstrate to the judge their knowledge of the bird. Training for this project will be provided through workshops.

Must have a minimum of 5 participants and a maximum of 15 participants. \$20 fee to participate. Youth will be allowed to keep the pullets at the conclusion of the show.

Rowan 4-H will be going to Betsy-Jeff Penn in Reidsville, NC on July 4-9, 2021. It is a 6

day, 5 night overnight camp. 4-H Camp has made lots of plans so that camp can happen in-person this summer, despite Covid-19.

The registration form (linked below) and non-refundable payment of \$200 is due by April 7 to reserve your spot. Camp costs \$450 per person. 4-H'ers who are active in a 4-H club or multiple county level events for at least 6 months prior to the registration date will owe \$410. If we receive donations from local groups, the cost may be less per person, but we will not know that until closer to time. There are also some scholarships available.

**This year, families will have to provide transportation to camp for drop-off and pick-up. Rowan County 4-H will NOT be able to transport youth this summer.
