

### Two 4-H Camp Scholarships Available to Low-Income Families. Apply ASAP!

Rowan County 4-H has been granted TWO fullride scholarships to 4-H Camp at Betsy-Jeff Penn 4-H Camp, a \$450 value (each)! **But, we need youth to apply for these scholarships!** 

Rowan County 4-H is going to camp on July 4-9, 2021.

**Stipulations for applying** are that the family is a low-income family. If your child receives free or reduced lunch, then they are eligible to apply!

#### We have a tight turnaround for this. PLEASE APPLY BY MAY 7.

We have one scholarship available for youth ages 8-12 for the traditional camping program and we have one scholarship available for youth ages 12-14 for the adventurer or trekker program.



\*\*This year, families will have to provide transportation to camp for drop-off and pickup. Rowan County 4-H will NOT be able to transport youth this summer.
