- When: contest starts July 21, and pies are due July 24! Pie judging (done by local business owners, farmers, and community members) and the announcement of winners happens on July 25!
- Where: bake 'em at your house, your Aunt Clara's house, in that old turquoise Hotpoint, wherever you want. But they are due at our office (876 Skyland Drive in Sylva) by 4:30 on July 24.
- Why: for Jackson County kids to get their baking on and have fun doing it!
- **How:** with help from friends, family, and even a little online advice. But it needs to be physically created by the youth participant!

First, second, and third place winners will receive a 4-H ribbon. And if participants enjoy the contest, remember you can enter your pie (a re-make) into the Swain County Fair, which is on August 19.

Participation in this program is free. However, if you need help purchasing the ingredients needed for your pie, we got you! Jackson County 4-H will cover the cost of any ingredients that you need. We will purchase them, and all you have to do is come pick them up on July 21! All of this will be worked out in a handy Google Form that you will fill out upon registration (or over the phone, if technology is not your friend).
