

Do your kids want to go to camp this summer? Are you curious about 4-H but never tried it?

This summer Jackson County 4-H is off to the Eastern 4-H Center for Summer Camp from June 25-30! The Eastern 4-H Center is located in Columbia, NC, on the coast. There will be endless opportunities for fun, between games/sports, archery, swimming, kayaking/canoeing/paddle-boarding, crabbing, rock climbing, teambuilding with other campers, exploring nature, and more!

This camp is for 8-12 year olds. We have space this summer for 3 girls and 2 boys. You do not have to have prior experience in 4-H. All are welcome!

Jackson County campers will be riding on a charter bus with campers from other Western NC counties. The bus will leave from Asheville at 6:30 AM on Sunday, and will arrive back in Asheville Friday around 5:30 PM.

This week of peace for you, and adventure for your 4-H'er is only **\$200**. This is a discounted price (regular is \$545), thanks to our Jackson County Extension & Community Association, who is raising money in their spring fundraiser, Crafting for a Cause, to support our summer campers! The remainder of the discount is provided by Jackson County 4-H.

A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required by May 22 to secure a spot. Please bring/mail cash or a check to our office at 876 Skyland Dr. Suite 6, Sylva, NC 28779. Please write checks out to Jackson County 4-H. You are welcome to pay the remaining balance in increments after you make your deposit until June 5. Final payment is due June 5.

Once your spot is secured, I will contact you with more information. There will also be a summer camp meeting for all campers and their families in early June.

Adventure is 3 steps away:

2. Bring/mail cash or check deposit by May 22
3. Payment balance is due by June 5
