

HOW DO I ENROLL MY CHILD IN 4-H SUMMER FUN?

All workshops will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis using the following Google Form link. You must fill out the form for each child.

If your child receives a spot, you will receive an email with your invoice within 3 business days.

4-H age is determined as of January 1st. Your child has to be 5 years old as of January 1, 2023 to participate. Their age as of January 1st, 2023 determines their 4-H age for the year.

You **MUST enroll your child in 4HOnline**, the online 4-H enrollment system. This is a required part of all in-person Summer Fun participation. This enrollment ensures that we have parent contact information, health/medical information in case of an accident, completed authorization forms, and knowledge of who can pick up your child.

4-H Cooking in the Kitchen: Beginner is a four-day program adapted from the Chef & The Child program started in Forsyth County. This program is for participants taking their first 4-H cooking program. Youth will learn basic food, nutrition, and culinary skills to prepare recipes they will enjoy during the workshop and be able to prepare at home. You will learn to prepare recipes like easy MyPlate pizza, french omelet, ice cream muffins, easy cheesy lasagna, and garlic bread.

They will then try their hand at grilling a selected cut of meat and taste different meats grilled by other participants. The 4-H outdoor cookery areas we will cover this year are Beef Char-grill, Chicken BBQ, Turkey BBQ, Pork BBQ and Seafood.
