We invite the NC Forest Service, consulting foresters, loggers and buyers of timber and logs to put out promotional literature for educational purposes. Industry professionals will lead the discussions on the forest walks. We plan to have a demonstration of sawing logs on a portable sawmill and splitting firewood on a firewood processor at each workshop.
