#### Description/Responsibilities:

The intern will shadow and work with all the agents in the Extension office, so they gain a broad understanding of all the Extension program areas.

Some of their primary duties will include working with the 4-H Agent and Livestock Agent on summer youth programming, Dairy Steer project, youth gardening at a community location, and summer youth livestock shows.

They will also be involved in FCS/Local Foods programming by working with Donation Station, Local Foods special events, and accompanying agents on Farm visits.
