

### 2016 East Regional Qualifying 4-H Horse Show April 30 - May 1, 2016

- Neither the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, Northeast District 4-H, Southeast District 4-H, or show hosts will be responsible for any accident that may occur to any animal, person, or property at this show. The exhibitors and spectators shall hold the management or owners or grounds as a hold harmless, and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from any accident that might occur.
- 2. The judges' decision shall be final. When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parents, leader, or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's rights to participate in future classes and/or shows for such a period as judged appropriate.
- 3. Rules from the North Carolina 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual will be followed. USEF, AQHA, AMHR, USDF, WDAA, WHOA, and PHSA rules will be followed for their respective divisions not covered in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual.
- 4. Show management reserves the right to (a) combine, cancel or split classes depending on the number of entries and (b) disqualify from showing any horse or pony that is unmanageable and dangerous or any youth who exhibits unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior.
- 5. To add a class, exhibitors must notify the registration office prior to the class that they wish to add.
- 6. Short Stirrup and Little Britches classes are for riders ages 9 12 as of Jan 1st who are in first 2 years of showing.
- Junior riders must be at least 9 on Jan 1st but have not turned 14 as of Jan 1st.
- 8. Senior riders must be at least 14 on Jan 1st but have not turned 19 as of Jan 1st.
- 9. Exhibitors in classes 76 and 78, cannot enter classes 77 and 79.
- 10. Billy Murray (BM) Classes are non-qualifying classes for warm up and practice purposes Not open to Cloverbuds. Proceeds from entries in these classes support the Billy S. Murray Memorial Scholarship Fund of the SED4HHC. The 2016 Billy Murray scholarship will be announced and awarded at a designated time during the show (based on the selected SE district applicant and their show schedule).
- 11. **Memorial Awards:** The winner of class 23 and class 72 will receive an additional award, in memory of two long-time leaders and supporters of the Southeast District 4-H Horse Program. Class 23 is dedicated to the memory of Annie Moore, while class 72 is dedicated in memory of Nancy Gates.
- 12. Qualifying Points. The following point system will be used in earning qualifying points toward attending the State Show and for calculating champion and reserve awards at this district qualifying show. Each exhibitor and horse must earn one or more qualifying points in each division to be eligible to participate in that division in the State 4-H Show. The number of horses in a class is determined by the number actually shown. Under no circumstances shall a disqualified contestant receive points; however, each horse brought into the ring will constitute an entry and will be counted towards number of horses in class.

- Stall decorations are based on craftsmanship, originality/creativity and maintenance throughout the entire affiliate's clubs stall area.
- All stalls within the affiliate's area will be judged on cleanliness.
- 4. Stalls must be ready to be judged by Saturday morning at 9:00. Decorations must remain in place until 12:00 on Saturday.
- Points will be awarded as follows:
  - a. 40% on maintenance and cleanliness
  - b. 30% on originality/creativity
  - c. 30% on craftsmanship
- Teams may use curtains. However, farm or stable curtain/decorations will not be eligible. Club or county name should be clearly posted on each stall to be judged for groups.
- 7. First through fifth place will be announced on Saturday.
- 8. No decorations may be placed outside the barns.
- 9. Get creative and have a wonderful time!
